5. To develop an awareness of good nutrition and the importance of being and staying healthy.
6. To offer support for parents of children enrolled in the Preschool program.

These goals are met through the following:

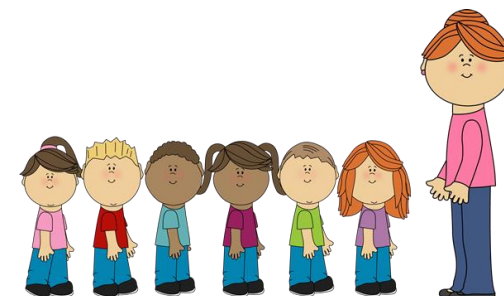
Role Play - children love to pretend

Aviston Elementary is now enrolling students for the 2017-2018 school year.

\$65.00 Registration Fee

We are now accepting this fee to guarantee your child a spot in the Preschool Program. 4-year-olds will take precedence over 3-year-old enrollment.

****Tuition Fee** - Please note that the preschool tuition fee has not been finalized for the 2017-2018 school year. A final monthly rate will be determined at the May 23 school board meeting. Aviston Preschool receives neither state funding support nor local tax levy funds directly for its operation. As the school's projected budget continues to show deep deficits, the school must make every effort to have users pay for all extra programs. As soon a final tuition figure is determined, you will be contacted.

***This fee does include door-to-door transportation for in-district Preschool students.*

Enrollment Information

Aviston Elementary is now enrolling preschool students for the 2017-2018 school year. To reserve a spot for your child, please register before **June 1, 2016**. We are confident that seats will fill-up quickly. Please fill out the registration form and send the non-refundable \$65.00 registration fee to the Aviston Elementary School office. If only one class is offered, four-year-old students will have the first chance for enrollment. The registration fee will only be returned if your child is not offered a seat in the program.

What does your child need to register?

Each student starting Preschool will need the following:

- **A certified birth certificate** – must be a courthouse copy, not a hospital copy
- **A physical exam & immunization record** – we must have a current physical exam and updated immunization record on file. The student must have had the exam within a year of the start of school.

****A supply list and other paperwork will be mailed to your home closer to the start of the school year.**
