Hofelich 5th Grade Extra Credit

Doing an extra credit project will add 2 points to a student's <u>final</u> quarter grade. For example, if a student's final reading grade is a 92% B+, your new final grade along with the extra credit would be a 94% A. You may only do one project per quarter in each subject.

Social Studies: (choose one)

- *Typed front-page report on a topic of the quarter
- *Sketch 3 scenes from history (Ex. Boston Tea Party)
- *List 20 important points about any state (Ex. Flower, location, climate)
- *Give 10 clues about someone in history or a president (listed in order from most difficult to the easiest)
- *Interview someone 60 or older, asking questions about school and home life back when they were children. Answers need to be more than just yes or no. Get details. It can be a tape or a written out interview of at least 15 questions.

Math:

Completion of 5 drill lessons handed out the last two weeks of the quarter scoring a grade of C or better.

English: (choose one)

- *A 2-page creative writing story (neat and grammatically correct)
- *Three descriptive paragraphs about a subject without telling what it is
- *Three illustrated haikus or similar poems

There is no extra credit for **spelling**.

If you have your own idea for an extra credit project, talk to me about it. It must have your name, subject, and quarter on the top of the page. It will **not** be returned.
