Students who have been vomiting or have had contagious (viral or bacterial) diarrhea must remain home until they are **12** hours without an episode.

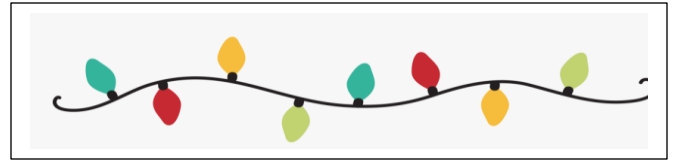
A FRIENDLY REMINDER...
